Gentlemen:

The Building Inspector has advised me that you are in the process of gathering information for a proposed building/remodeling in the Village of Brown Deer.

I would like to advise you that a fire prevention code exists in our community which makes certain fire control, suppression and alarm equipment mandatory in new/remodeled construction. Of primary concern to you would be the required installation of a complete sprinkler system.

The code also contains a provision which allows the undersigned authority to waive the sprinkler provision if, and I quote "where the installation of sprinklers may increase the hazard; nor shall it be construed in any way to interfere with the substitution of other automatic protective equipment, approved by the Village Director of Public Safety".

Requests for variance must be in writing, addressed to the undersigned, and contain the reasons why the builder/owner wishes to install an alternate fire protection and alarm system in lieu of sprinklers. Upon receipt of a request, the undersigned and members of the fire department staff will review the proposal and any available information, sending a decision to you with recommendations in writing.
