Special Notes:

1. Every swimming pool exceeding 4 feet in depth shall be equipped with a reasonable number of life preservers or other safety devices.
2. Public swimming pools shall conform with the rules of the State Board of Health.
3. A fence permit is required where fences are built.
4. All exterior electrical receptacles shall be protected by a ground fault circuit interrupter.
5. Electrical and plumbing permits are required for electrical or plumbing work incidental to pool construction.

A SWIMMING POOL PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR ALL INSTALLED SWIMMING POOLS. Submit a copy of your survey showing location of pool on the lot, measurements of setbacks from lot lines and buildings, and fencing-if planned-plus descriptive literature indicating pool construction and appearance.
